

Open Call: Web Developer

The **Erasmus Student Network** (ESN) is Europe's biggest student organisation, present in 500 Higher Education Institutions in 38 European countries. Our aim is to support and develop student mobility and the internationalisation of higher education, through providing services and opportunities to students. Every year, ESN maintains and develops several IT tools such as its intranet ESN Galaxy and its webpage template ESN Satellite.

The Headquarters is responsible for managing the Network, developing and implementing new projects and advocating for student mobility and internationalisation of higher education. The Network is led by the International Board of ESN which is supported by the Secretariat.

The Board of ESN International, based in Brussels, is looking for a **Web Developer starting as soon as possible**. The person will work on developing, maintaining and documenting a high-traffic online Drupal platform while at the same time providing support to various smaller Drupal projects.

The position is a full time position preferably starting in May 2016 with a one-year contract.
