

## Open Call: Web Developer

The person will work on developing, maintaining and documenting a high-traffic online Drupal platform while at the same time providing support to various smaller Drupal projects. The position is a full time position starting in December 2015/January 2016 with a contract of 6 months with a chance of renewal.
