

Call for ESC volunteer in Training and Development 2023

Erasmus Student Network (ESN) is the largest student network in Europe, with over 500 local organisations (“sections”) active in Higher Education Institutions in more than 40 countries. ESN has been supporting student mobility since 1989 and has its international headquarters in Brussels.

The international headquarters in Brussels is looking for a **European Solidarity Corps volunteer, starting on the 1st of June 2023 (ideally) and staying for 12 months** (this is negotiable). Due to the nature of the Solidarity Corps programme, the candidate must be **between 17 and 30 years old and resident of an Erasmus+ Programme country**. The volunteer will support the content creation of various events across our network, mainly ESN’s very own training programme Eduk8, as well as various development initiatives for our member organisations and volunteers like validation of volunteer work.

The volunteer will work in the Training and Events department of ESN International and will be supervised by the Vice President for Development and will work together with the Events and Projects Officer.

Main tasks and responsibilities

- Support the implementation of ESN’s training programme to build capacity of volunteers around Europe to promote and represent youth active in international mobility opportunities;
- Support the development of ESN’s trainers and T4T opportunities to support the capacity building of volunteers and young people;
- Support the organisation of training events for the volunteers and members in ESN;
- Help with the implementation of both internal and external projects related to training and development;
- Support the teams of ESN in implementing the training and development strategies;
- Manage the production of education manuals/toolkits and TSOs in line with ESN’s projects;
- Support the development of non-formal learning processes, tools and opportunities in ESN;
- Assist the Board and Secretariat with other tasks that might come up in the field of training and learning development;

Note: The Solidarity Corps programme is a learning experience for the volunteer, and they should feel free to suggest their own tasks and projects, in addition to those mentioned above.

Terms and conditions

- European Solidarity Corps volunteer contract for a duration of **12 months**;
- The successful applicant should **start in June 2023, ideally on the 1st**;
- **Accommodation** in Brussels is provided, either in the “ESN House” or on the private market with assistance from ESN and with the rent up to 450 EUR per month paid by ESN;

- **Transport costs** in Brussels are covered;
- **Health Insurance** is covered through the ESC programme;
- **Pocket money** of 450 EUR per month is provided;
- **Travel costs** to Brussels from the volunteer's home country and back are covered.

Qualifications & Requirements

- Good written communication skills;
- Flexibility with working outside of regular working hours from time to time;
- Adaptability and willingness to work in an intercultural environment;
- Experience with non-formal education;
- Experience with organising training events;
- Experience in coordinating the content of training events;
- Experience in a volunteer-led organisation;
- Structured and reliable way of working;
- Experience with volunteering in ESN is a plus;
- Experience with carrying out EU-funded projects and grants is a plus
