

Open Call: EVS Volunteer for Training and Development

The Erasmus Student Network (ESN) is Europe's biggest student organisation, present in over 500 local associations in 39 European countries. It was founded in 1989, with the aim to support and develop student mobility.

The international office in Brussels is **looking for an EVS* volunteer, starting as soon as possible (ideally) and staying for 10 months** (this is negotiable). Due to the nature of the EVS programme, the candidate must **be between 17 and 30 years old and resident in either Croatia or Spain**. The volunteer will work on ESN's training programme [Eduk8](#), as well as with ESN's alumni scheme - in the context of training and capacity building.

Terms and conditions

- EVS volunteer contract for a duration of **10 months**;
- Starting date **ideally in March** (exact date to be discussed during interview);
- **Accommodation** in Brussels is provided up to 450 EUR per month;
- **Transport costs** in Brussels are covered;
- **Insurance** is covered;
- **Pocket money** of 400 EUR per month is provided;
- **Language classes** during working hours is covered;
- **Travel costs** to Brussels from Croatia/Spain and back are covered.

Required skills and experience

- Good written communications skills;
- Experience with non-formal learning;
- Experience with carrying out projects;
- Experience in a volunteer-led organisation;
- Structured and reliable way of working;
- Experience in working with/writing/editing publications;
- Knowledge of ESN is a plus;
- Experience in managing grants is a plus;



Main tasks and responsibilities

- Support with the development of ESN's training programme Eduk8;
- Oversee some projects and help with the implementation of several grants related to training and development;
- Manage the production of education manuals/toolkits;
- Support the development of ESN's alumni scheme and organise an event for ESN's alumni;
- Organise a training event for for ESN's staff in Brussels;
- Assist the Board and Secretariat with other tasks that might come up;
- EVS is a learning experience for the volunteers, and they should feel free to suggest their own tasks and projects, in addition to those mentioned above.
