

Open Call: EVS Volunteers

The Erasmus Student Network (ESN) is Europe's biggest student organisation, present in 520 local sections in 40 European countries. It was founded in 1989, with the aim to support and develop student mobility.

The international office in Brussels is **looking for two EVS* volunteers, starting in March (ideally) and staying for 12 months** (this is negotiable). Due to the nature of the EVS program, the candidates must be **between 17 and 30 years old and resident in either Croatia or Portugal**. The volunteers will work with the rest of ESN on promoting European culture through mobility and also work on various other ESN projects. The exact task division between the two volunteers will be discussed both at the interview and once the volunteering starts.

Terms and conditions

- EVS volunteer contract for a duration of **12 months**;
- Starting date **ideally in March** (exact date to be discussed during interview);
- **Accommodation** in Brussels is provided;
- **Transport costs** in Brussels are covered;
- **Insurance** is covered;
- **Pocket money** of 200 EUR per month is provided;
- **Language classes** during working hours is covered;
- **Travel costs** to Brussels from Croatia/Portugal and back are covered.

Required skills and experience

- Experience with projects;
- Experience in a volunteer-led organisation;
- Structured and reliable way of working;
- Knowledge in topics discussed on a European level, including youth, culture and Erasmus+;
- Knowledge of ESN is a plus.

Main tasks and responsibilities

- Assist ESN organising activities related to mobility, especially in the frame of the European Year of Cultural Heritage;
- Cooperate and communicate with ESN sections to help organising cultural activities;
- Assist ESN in developing other projects;
- Assist ESN in organising activities related to its internal development;
- Liaise with project teams in ESN;
- Assist the Board and Secretariat with other tasks that might come up;

- EVS is a learning experience for the volunteers, and they should feel free to suggest their own tasks and projects, in addition to those mentioned above.
